LACROSSE GOALS No. 261100 Portable No. 262100 Stationary

- Check all components for structural integrity. Replace damaged components immediately.
- Check all connecting hardware before every use. Replace damaged or missing fasteners immediately.
- Fully disassemble goals for seasonal storage.
- Do not use or store goals on a sloped surface.




Upon completion of the assembly/installation of these goals, make sure this instruction manual is on the possession of the owner or facility manager, to save for future reference, and to order replacement parts.


No. 261100 PORTABLE LACROSSE GOAL

- 1. Check all items against Parts List on Page 1 to ensure all have been included.
- 2. Assemble base sections as shown in Detail "A".
- 3. Insert inside cap plugs into each end of crossbar. See Detail "B".



- 4. Assemble posts to base sections. Assemble crossbar to posts. Note – orient posts and crossbar so that attachment hardware is toward the rear of the goal. See Detail "B". Tighten all set screws.
- 5. The assembled goals must be secured to the ground using the tie-down stakes provided. Each base section contains a slot for a tie-down stake. Locate the portable lacrosse goals in their final position on the playing field, and drive a tie-down stake thru each slot (two per goal) to secure them to the ground. See Detail "C".






- 6. Install net to frame using lacing cord provided with net. Secure the net to the ground using the tie-down stakes provided. Locate one tie-down stake at the back end of the net. Use three tie-down stakes (evenly spaced) along each side of the net.
- 7. Assembly of goal is now complete.


No. 262100 STATIONARY LACROSSE GOAL

- 7. Check all items against Parts List on Page 1 to ensure all have been included.
- 2. The lacrosse goals will be pre-assembled on the ground, before being installed in the concrete footings.
- 3. Insert inside cap plugs into each end of crossbar. See Detail "D".
- 4. Assemble crossbar to posts as shown in Detail "D". Tighten set screws.

If lacrosse goals are being used with outdoor ground sleeves, follow the installation instructions provided with the ground sleeves. If lacrosse goals are being installed permanently into concrete footings, proceed to Step No. 4.



Locate and dig footings for uprights.
 <u>CAUTION</u> – Contact your local utility companies to locate buried electrical, gas and water lines <u>before digging holes for footings</u>. Also, check for overhead utilities. See Detail "E".



- 6. Raise the assembled lacrosse goal into position, with the bottom end of the uprights suspended in the holes for the footings. Support the goal assembly at the proper location and height, with 2x4's, etc. The bottom of the crossbar must be located exactly 6'-0" above the playing surface, with the face of the goal even with the outer edge of the court line. See Detail "E".
- 7. After double-checking the position of the lacrosse goal, pour the concrete footings.
- 8. Allow the concrete footings to cure for a minimum of three days before assembling the lacrosse net to the goal. The net is secured to the goal with the lacing cord provided with the net.
- 9. Secure the net to the ground using the tie-down stakes provided. Locate one tie-down stake at the back end of the net. Use three tie-down stakes (evenly spaced) along each side of the net.
- 10. Assembly of goal is now complete.
